At the OGS

Solar Hot Water System Installed

The OGS has a new solar domestic hot water heating system that became operational in September and is well on its way to saving the OGS 66% in reduced propane usage for heating the domestic hot water in the building.

The OGS is grateful to the West Penn Power Sustainable Energy Fund for granting 60% of the cost of the new system. Chilton Designs, of Boalsburg provided the engineering, S. C. Bierly of Millheim installed the system, and Poorman's Welding of Aaronsburg, fabricated the sub-structures for mounting the system.

At noon on December 7^{th} , the temperature at the solar collectors was $283^{\circ}F!$ A 500-gallon water tank stores the heat from the solar collectors and distributes pre-heated water into the domestic hot water system whenever hot water is called for.

Food Centre: Feeding the Community

A project by New Leaf Initiative and the Food Reclamation Network of Centre County, a Food Centre may be coming to Penns Valley at the OGS. Winners of the Centre Inspires grant through Centre Foundation, the goal of the Food Centre is to provide a solution to food insecurity in our community.

The Food Centre would provide refrigerated storage in a retrofitted shipping container in order to store food that would otherwise spoil before being distributed to those who need it. Food from local farmers, grocery stores, and restaurants would be collected before it is wasted and stored at the center to be distributed by organizations in Penns Valley such as the Penns Valley Youth Center and the Millheim Outreach Center.

Chosen as the possible location for the first Food Centre, the Old Gregg School would be a great partner in accomplishing the mission of the Food Centre. One example is the potential for the OGS commercial kitchen to be used by Food Centre partners for classes about cooking and nutrition. A community garden may also be in the works at the OGS to give hands-on learning opportunities to youth and their families in Penns Valley.

The Penns Valley Youth Center, located at the OGS, provides food to the community through their Bread Pick-Up program and Wednesday Dinner for teens. With the Food Centre, PVYC would be able to give fresh produce to those families, as well as teach them about healthy options in regard to food choices.

With the OGS working together with organizations like the Food Reclamation Network of Centre County and PVYC, we can be a part of ending food insecurity right here in our own neighborhoods.

The Underground: Fitness Center Memberships

We have some exciting changes going on with our fitness center and gymnasium!

The fitness center, located in the basement of the OGS below the gym, is now known as *The Underground*. Didn't know we had a fitness center? There are free weights, weight machines, and much more. If you are looking for a low-key cross-fit style gym that is affordable, then we want to welcome you to The Underground!

Instead of paying \$2 per day, you now have the ease of bringing your membership card. First time visitors pay \$2 and then have the option of purchasing a membership for continued use.
